seven million children have a parent in prison, on probation or parole.

half of all women in prison are incarcerated more than 100 miles from their families.

most women entering prison have been convicted of non-violent crimes.

two-thirds have less than a high school education 1 in 5 are homeless.

70% of all inmates are illiterate.
